Farmer's Corner

Hello Everyone!

We survived summer!

Even though our summer heat and drought is a regularity in the Gulf Coast, at the end of every summer we feel a sense of accomplishment and relief that cooler temperatures are on their way.

Don't be fooled by dropping temperatures quite yet, as we typically have highs in the 90s until the last few weeks of September. If your vegetable gardens are still active, you'll want to make sure to keep vigilant about watering until we can relax some in October.

We hope you've all been able to see the continued development of the Southfields (the crop area in front of the model homes) as we work on improving the soil in this area. Most recently, we spread 200 yards of compost here to improve the texture for vegetable growing.

At The Village Farm Proper (just south of the high school's baseball field) we're harvesting summer II crops and getting ready for our fall plantings to start in early October. Once the Harlem Road construction settles down and our parking lot and pedestrian bridge are in place, we will begin tours and classes.

Make sure to join us on November 5th for the Harvest Festival. It will be quite a production! Watch Sylvia's emails and this newsletter for more information to come.

If you're out at the farms and see one of our Farm Educators, don't hesitate to stop them to ask any quick questions you may have. If they don't have the answer, they'll find it for you. You'll be able to recognize our staff by their Agmenity branded shirts.
