HOA Update

GARBAGE PICK UP SCHEDULE

Garbage service commences as soon as water services have been set up for the property. For more information on setting up your water services visit Si Environmental Customer Service online at <http://www.sienv.com/>, or call them directly at 832-490-1600.

Billing for waste services is not included in your yearly assessment it is included on the monthly water bill. If you have any questions about trash pick-up, please call Republic Services at 713-726-7300 or visit them online at <http://www.republicservices.com/>.

TRASH CANS: Property owners will receive one 95 - gallon trash can for each individual home from Republic Services.

- House hold trash pick-up days are Monday and Thursday.
- All garbage will be collected curbside.
- Bulk trash will be picked up on the second Wednesday of each month. There is a limit of 2 heavy items per address.

RECYCLING: Property owners will receive one 95 -gallon can for each individual home and recycling is picked up every Monday.

- All recycling cans will be picked up curbside.

YARD TRIMMINGS: Yard Trimmings, grass clippings, small branches and leaves will be picked up every Wednesday, curbside.

- Branches must be put in bundles and cannot exceed 5 feet in length, 3 to 4 inches in diameter, and weigh no more than 50 pounds. There is a limit of 4 bundles per pick up day.

Note when setting up services: MUD District 134D & 134E - Water is set up and billed through Si Environmental. Trash must be set up through Republic Services & then billed through Si Environmental. Please contact Si Environmental first then contact Republic Services.

Trash may only be placed outside for collection the evening before collection. Such trash must be contained to protect from animals or spillage, and trash cans must be removed from sight the same evening of collection.
