THE FIELDS ARE STIRRING!

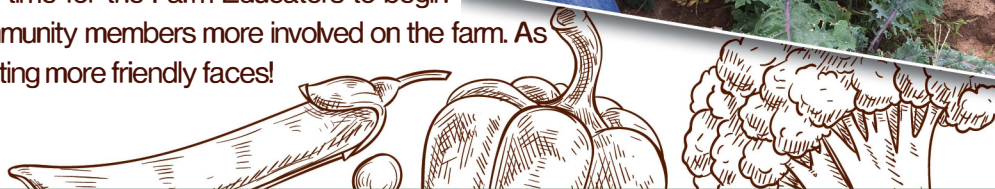
